


ARTICLE 30 - SEVERABILITY AND SAVINGS

- 30.1 If, during the life of this Agreement, there exists any applicable law or any applicable rule, regulation or order issued by governmental authority other than that of the District or decision of a court of competent jurisdiction which shall render any provision of this Agreement invalid, such provision shall be immediately suspended and be of no effect hereunder so long as such law, rule, regulation or order shall remain in effect. Such invalidation of a part or portion of this Agreement shall not invalidate any remaining portions which shall continue in full force and effect.
- 30.2 Upon request of either the District or Association, the Article affected by an invalidated provision will be renegotiated.
- 30.3 This agreement is effective July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2024. The only re-openers during the specified time will be Article 9 – Compensation & Term and Appendix A – Salary and two additional re-openers from each side for each year of the agreement. If any additional funding is received by the District over current budget projections or if major deficits in funding occur, both parties agree to meet and negotiate Article(s) related to funding.
